Of the Annual Meeting of the Lehigh Valley Educators Credit Union

March 11, 2023

The Annual Meeting was held at Parkland High School, Allentown, Pennsylvania.

President William Ayers called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. Secretary Eugenia Emert established that a quorum was present.

Annual Reports and Minutes were provided to attendees and posted on the LVECU website. A motion to accept the Minutes of the 2022 Annual Meeting was made by Gary Fedorcha, seconded by Gary Phillips. Motion passed.

President Ayers introduce the Board members and the Executive team, followed by Rosemarie Krantz, Chief Executive Officer, introducing staff members in attendance.

A motion to accept the Annual Reports was made by Gary Fedorcha, seconded by Dan Joseph. Motion passed.

President Ayers, serving as Nominating Committee Chairperson proxy, presented the slate of directors who were unopposed. President Ayers, as Nominating Committee Chairperson proxy, cast the ballot for the election. Eugenia Emert, Gary Fedorcha and Gary Phillips were elected to the board for a three-year term.

Old Business: None

New Business: Daniel Joseph announced the ten Scholarship winners for 2023. The recipients were each given \$1,000. Four of the students were in attendance to receive their recognition. Over the last 22 years, over \$210,000 has been awarded to students.

President Ayers recognized Lori Seier and her staff for preparing the breakfast.

A motion to adjourn the Annual Meeting was made by Gary Fedorcha. The Annual Meeting was adjourned at 10:23 a.m.

Board & Management

Annual Report

The Board, Management and Staff wish to welcome you to the 90th Annual Meeting of the Lehigh Valley Educators Credit Union (LVECU) and want to sincerely thank you for your continued support.

LVECU is considered "well capitalized" by the Pennsylvania Department of Banking and Securities and the National Credit Union Administration. We recently received an excellent 5-Star rating from Bauer Financial, an organization that has been rating banks and credit unions since 1983. Their creed is "no institution pays for its ratings, nor can they elude them." Also, LVECU won the Silver Award for credit unions in the CommunityVotes Allentown.

In 2023 we experienced moderate loan growth, increasing our portfolio by \$5.3 million. During the same period shares grew \$3.1 million. We had a profitable year, ending with \$792,632 in net income. This was less than usual because, in March, the Board agreed to sell ~\$30 million in US Treasuries, which attributed to a loss of ~\$3.5 million. The US Treasuries were sold because they were underperforming investments yielding between 0.38% and 1.25%. The funds were reinvested in higher yielding investments. From March to September the credit union had a net loss due to the sale of these Treasuries; however, in October we had a profit of \$224,045. The increase in loan rates plus loan growth and higher yields on investments all attributed to our profitability. Our return on assets ended at 0.19% and our capital remains very strong at 16.03%.

During the year, VISA Platinum credit cardholders received a total of \$205,425 in Cash Back rewards. To reward depositors, we offered various high-rate Term Share Certificate Specials with dividend rates ranging between 4.89% - 5.37% and APY between 5.00% - 5.50%.

LVECU continues to support the local educational community. In 2023 we participated in the Lehigh County Schools Backpack program by donating \$10,000 to each participating school district to assist with providing for their students' educational needs. We also continued our tradition of awarding ten \$1,000 scholarships to local high school and college students who have performed well and have demonstrated a sincere interest in furthering their education. We wish all the scholarship winners success with their future endeavors. In the past 23 years we have awarded \$225,000 in scholarships.

The credit union is fortunate to have a great Staff and a supportive Board. Six Board members have served this credit union on a volunteer basis for over 15 years, and three have served for at least 5 years. Four employees have been here between 5 and 10 years; 4 between 11 and 15 years; 2 between 16 and 20 years; 5 between 20 and 25 years; 2 between 26 and 30 years; 2 between 30 and 35 years; and 1 over 35 years! The Board and Staff members are what make LVECU the best Financial Institution it can be.

Although we anticipated enhancing technology in 2023, not all went as planned. In 2024, credit and debit card conversions are underway with a new vendor, and all new cards will be issued for both products. The new credit cards will include the contactless feature. We are enhancing security within Online banking (e-Tran) and adding Online payment options so members can process payments using another institution's debit card without having to speak with a credit union representative.

2023 was a year of challenges. Interest rates continued to rise through July and inflation continued to be a major concern for many. Economic uncertainty remains; but whatever the economy may bring, your financial well-being remains our focus. Please know that regardless of how large we grow, we will always remain committed to providing the best and most-personalized member service possible. Looking forward to 2024, we, the Board of Directors, the Executive Management Team and the Staff all stand poised and ready to achieve remarkable things.

Thank you for your trust and confidence in us.
