Board of Directors Election 2022...Your Chance to Make a Difference

Election for the 2022 Board of Directors is coming soon. Make sure you vote for the credit union leaders who will work for you.

If interested in contributing your time and talent and are a member in good standing, submit your letter of introduction (100 words or less) to: **Nomination Committee, c/o LVECU, 3720 Hamilton Blvd., Allentown PA 18103**. The deadline for receiving nominations is **November 30, 2021**. Ballots and biographies will be mailed (if necessary) to all members age 18 and over after the close of nominations.

By resolution of the Board of Directors, incumbent directors will be automatically re-nominated, provided they wish to run. The Nominating Committee may nominate one additional person for each position. Anyone not nominated by the committee may have his/her name added to the ballot by submitting a nominating petition with the signatures of 25 LVECU members. Petitions are available upon request. Nominees must be members in good standing as defined by the credit union bylaws.

Holiday Scams and How to Avoid Them

As the holiday season approaches, don't let scams ruin your cheer! Here are a few scams to watch out for over the next few months:

Credit Card Information Theft

Remember that financial institutions will never ask you for your personal information by email or text. Some scammers will send an email that looks like it is from your financial institution asking to verify a purchase with a link to your login information. Do not enter that information. Call your financial institution immediately!

Hot Holiday Deals

Who doesn't love a good deal?! If you receive a text or email advertising a price on a popular product, and it seems too good to be true, it probably is. This is especially true if retailers are out of stock.

Mobile Phishing

Phishing happens when scammers send a text message with a link, hoping you will click on it and provide personal information. Don't click on links in texts, even if that text is forwarded by a friend. Go directly to the website of the company claiming to send the text.
